ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 5TH FEBRUARY 1921.)

BERKSHIRE AND DISTRICT (MUZZLING AND CONTROL OF DOGS) ORDER OF 1921 (No. 2).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Contraction of Inner Controlled Area.

1. (1) The Inner Controlled Area to which the Berkshire and District (Muzzling and Control of Dogs) Order of 1920 (No. 2) for the time being applies is hereby contracted so as to comprise only the area described in the Schedule hereto, which shall be an Inner Controlled Area for the purposes of that Order.

(2) Such portions of the Inner Controlled Area to which the Berkshire and District (Muzzling and Control of Dogs) Order of 1920 (No. 2) for the time being applies as are hereby excluded from that area shall thereupon become subject to the provisions of the Berkshire and District (Muzzling and Control of Dogs) Order of 1920, and the Berkshire and District (Muzzling and Control of Dogs) Order of 1920 (No. 4) which relate to the scheduled district.

Local Authority to Enforce Order.

2. The provisions of this Order shall be executed and enforced by the Local Authority.

Commencement.

3. This Order shall come into operation on

the eighth day of February, nineteen hundred and twenty-one.

Short Title.

4. This Order may be cited as the BERKSHIRE AND DISTRICT (MUZZLING AND CONTROL OF DOGS) ORDER OF 1921 (No. 2).

The parishes of Whitchurch, Mapledurham, Kidmore End, Eye and Dunsden, Shiplake, and Harpsden;

And also comprising:—

The county borough of Reading.
