INFECTED PLACE.

The premises mentioned in the Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be a place infected with Foot-and-Mouth Disease.

ANIMALS (LANDING FROM IRELAND)
ORDER OF 1921 (No. 9).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested

in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Prohibition of Landing.

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Animals (Landing from Ireland) Consolidation and Amendment Order of 1914, cattle, sheep, goats or swine shipped from Ireland after the date of this Order shall not, unless and until it is otherwise ordered by the Minister, be landed at any port or place in Great Britain.

Revocation.

2. The Animals (Landing from Ireland) Orders of 1921 (Nos. 7 and 8) are hereby revoked.

Local Authority to Enforce Order.

3. The provisions of this Order shall be executed and enforced by the Local Authority.

Offences.

4. If any animal shall be landed in contravention of this Order, the owner thereof and the owner and the lessee and the occupier of the place of landing, and the person causing, directing, or permitting the landing, and the owner and the charterer and the master of the vessel from which the same is landed shall, each according to and in respect of his own acts or defaults, be deemed guilty of an offence against the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894.

Short Title.

5. This Order may be cited as the ANIMALS (LANDING FROM IRELAND) ORDER OF 1921 (No. 9).
