NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACTS, 1911 to 1920.

Notice is hereby given, under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Section 18 of the National Health Insurance Act, 1918, and by the National Insurance (Joint Committee) Regulations, 1918, to make regulations providing for the reduction, postponement or suspension of benefits in the case of insured persons who are in arrears, and repealing the National Health Insurance (Arrears) Regulations, 1918, the National Health Insurance (Arrears) Amendment Regulations, 1919, and the National Health Insurance (Arrears) Regulations, 1920.
