## SUMMARY.

The foregoing list contains 116 cases, viz. :—9 American, 1 Austrian, 1 Czecho-Slovak, 7 Danish, 2 Dutch, 6 French, 7 German, 8 Italian, 11 Polish, 2 Roumanian, 47 Russian, 3 Swedish, and 12 of other Nationalities. 13 of the cases (including 2 American, 1 Austrian, 1 Dutch, 1 French, 6 German, and 1 Roumanian) are British-born widows. 54 of the cases (including 1 Danish, 2 French, 1 German, 4 Italian, 4 Polish, 2 Roumanian, and 38 Russian) are men who have served in the British or Allied Forces during the War.
