The following Amendments to the Statutes of Queen's College, Oxford, made by the Governing Body of the College on the 8th June, 1921, have been submitted for the approval of His Majesty in Council, and notice of their having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of "The Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1877":—

Whereas it is expedient to change the title of The Hastings Exhibitions and The Hastings Exhibitioners into the title of The Hastings Scholarships and Scholars.

And also to provide that the aggregate income of two emoluments held together within the College shall be raised to £130.

And further that a consequential rearrangement of the order in the Statutes shall be made.

The College, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1877, and of any other power enabling it, at a General Meeting of the Governing Body, specially summoned for the purpose, and after due notice, held upon the 8th day of June, 1921, by the unanimous vote of the persons present and voting, made the following amendments to a Statute made by the University Commissioners for the Queen's College, Oxford, and ordered them to be submitted to His Majesty in Council, to be dealt with as provided by the said Act:

In the College Statutes, Title II., "A Statute for the Queen's College, Oxford, concerning the exhibitions within the College."

In Sectio. 1, Clause 1, entitled "Exhibitions in General," delete the words "and subject also to the provisions for the regulation of the Hastings Exhibitioners."

In Sectio. II., "The Hastings Exhibitions," wherever the word "Exhibition" or "Exhibitions" occurs, substitute the word "Scholarship" or "Scholarships," and whenever the word "Exhibitioner" or "Exhibitioners" occurs, substitute the word "Scholar" or "Scholars."

Ibid. Clause 12. For "One hundred and ten pounds per annum" substitute the words "One hundred and thirty pounds per annum."

In College Statutes, Title III., after the figure III., add the figure "1. The Scholars and Bible Clerks."

At the end of the Sectio, after Clause 13, add the Title "2. The Hastings Scholars," and then follows the whole of the Title II., Sectio. II., as amended, formerly called "The Hastings Exhibitions."

The College Seal was affixed upon the thirteenth day of June, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one.
