In the case of all Female Workers to whom this Section is applicable each Piece Rate paid must be such as would yield, in the circumstances of the case, not less than 8½d per hour to an ordinary worker, that is a Female Worker of ordinary skill and experience in the class of work in question.

Female Workers of 18 years of age and over, 9d. per hour.
Female Workers of 17 and under 18 years of age, 7½d. per hour.
Female Workers of 16½ and under 17 years of age, 6½d. per hour.
Female Workers of 16 and under 16½ years of age, 5½d. per hour.
Female Workers of 15½ and under 16 years of age, 4½d. per hour.
Female Workers of 15 and under 15½ years of age, 4d. per hour.
Female Workers of 14½ and under 15 years of age, 3½d. per hour.

Female Workers of 14 and under 14½ years of age, 3d. per hour.

SECTION II.—Proposed Piece-Work Basis Time-Rate:—

All Female Workers employed in Carding Hooks and Eyes or Snap Fasteners, 7½d. per hour.

In the case of all Female Workers to whom this Section is applicable, each Piece-Rate paid must be such as would yield, in the circumstances of the case, not less than 7½d. per hour to an ordinary worker, i.e., a worker of ordinary skill and experience in the class of work in question.
