SUMMARY.

The foregoing list contains 117 cases, viz. :—13 American, 1 Austrian, 3 Belgian, 3 Czecho-Slovak, 4 Danish, 3 Dutch, 7 French, 10 German, 1 Hungarian, 7 Italian, 6 Polish, 2 Roumanian, 34 Russian, 4 Swedish, 4 Swiss, and 14 of other Nationalities. 18 of the cases (including 1 American, 1 Danish, 10 German, 1 Hungarian, and 3 Russian) are British-born widows. 37 of the cases (including 1 Austrian, 4 French, 2 Italian, 4 Polish, 1 Roumanian, and 23 Russian) are men who have served in the British or Allied Forces during the War.
