PROPOSAL TO VARY MINIMUM RATES OF WAGES FOR MALE AND FEMALE WORKERS.

In accordance with Regulations made under Section 18 of the Trade Boards Act, 1909, by the Minister of Labour, and dated 31st October, 1918, the Trade Board established in Great Britain under the Trade Boards Act, 1918, for the Paper Bag Trade as specified in the Trade Boards (Paper Bag Trade) Order, 1919, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE, as required by Section 3 (5) of the Trade Boards Act, 1918, that they Propose to Vary the General Minimum Time-Rates and Overtime Rates for Male and Female Workers and the Piece-Work Basis Time-Rates for Female Workers at present fixed and set out in the Schedule to their Notice P. (5), dated 12th November, 1920, and effective under the Order of the Minister of Labour, dated 10th November, 1920, and that the proposed variations are as shown in the Schedule set out below.
