

by a Veterinary Inspector of the Ministry and unless and until the Inspector certifies that his examination and information do not show that there is, or during the voyage has been, an animal on board affected with Foot-and-Mouth Disease.

Local Authority to Enforce Order.

3. The provisions of this Order shall be executed and enforced by the Local Authority.

Offences.

4. If any animal shall be landed or moved in contravention to this Order, or is not slaughtered as hereby required, the owner thereof and the owner and the lessee and the occupier of the place of landing, and the person causing, directing or permitting the landing or movement, and the owner and person in charge of the animal which is not so slaughtered, and the owner and the charterer, and the master of the vessel from which the same is landed as the case may be, shall, each according to and in respect of his own acts or defaults, be deemed guilty of an offence against the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894.

Short Title.

5. This Order may be cited as the ANIMALS (LANDING FROM IRELAND) ORDER OF 1921 (No. 16).

SNETTISHAM DRAINAGE BOARD.

SPECIAL ACTS (EXTENSION OF TIME)
ACT, 1915.

Further extension of time for operation of certain provisions of the Northampton Corporation Water Act, 1913.

BOROUGH OF NORTHAMPTON.

WHEREAS by virtue of Section 20 of the Northampton Corporation Water Act, 1913 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1913"), and of Orders dated respectively the 26th day of September, 1916, the 7th day of July, 1917, the 7th day of August, 1918, and the 24th day of June, 1919, issued by the Local Government Board, and of an Order dated the 2nd day of July, 1920, issued by the Minister of Health, under Section 1 of the Special Acts (Extension of Time) Act, 1915 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1915"), the time limited for the exercise by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Northampton (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") of their powers for the compulsory purchase of lands under the Act of 1913, expired on the 4th day of July, 1921;

And whereas in pursuance of Section 1 of the Act of 1915 the Corporation applied to the Minister of Health before the said date for an Order extending the time during which the said powers might be exercised:

Now, therefore, the Minister of Health, in pursuance of the powers given to him by Section 1 of the Act of 1915, and of any other powers in that behalf, hereby extends until the 4th day of July, 1922, the time limited as aforesaid for the compulsory purchase of lands under the Act of 1913.

SPECIAL ACTS (EXTENSION OF TIME)
ACT, 1915

BY virtue and in pursuance of the provisions of the above named Act, the Minister of Transport hereby orders that the period limited (a) by Section 23 of the Northampton Corporation Act, 1911, for the construction of tramways, and (b) by Section
