C.—Proposed Variation of Overtime Rates.

In lieu of the Overtime Rates as at present fixed, Overtime Rates calculated on the Proposed Minimum Rates specified in this Part of this Schedule in the manner set out in Part III. of the Notice Q (2) issued by the Trade Board, dated 9th September, 1920, shall apply in substitution for the Proposed Minimum Rates otherwise applicable, as set out in this Part of this Schedule, in respect of all hours worked in excess of the number of hours declared by the Trade Board in the above-mentioned Notice Q (2), to be the normal number of hours of work in the Trade.
