GAS REGULATION ACT, 1920.

Application by the Mynyddislywn U.D.C. for an Order under Section 1 of the above-named Act.

NOTICE is hereby given, that the Mynyddislywn Urban District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Undertakers") have applied to the Board of Trade under the provisions of Section 1 of the Gas Regulation Act, 1920, for an Order providing for—

(a) the repeal of any enactments or other provisions requiring the Undertakers to supply gas of any particular illuminating value and the substitution therefor of power to charge for thermal units supplied in the form of gas; and

(b) the modification of the statutory or other provisions affecting the charges which may be made by the Undertakers by substituting for the maximum price per 1,000 cubic feet now authorised with an addition
