

Provided that a female Learner commencing employment in this section of the trade under the age of 18 years shall cease to be a Learner and become entitled to the General Minimum Time-Rate applicable to her under Sub-section (B) (1) of Section I of Part I of the above-mentioned Notice Z (8) on attaining the age of 18 years.

(d) Learners commencing employment in this section of the trade at the age of 18 years or over—

During the first six months of employment, 25s. per week of 48 hours.

During the second six months of employment, 30s. per week of 48 hours.

During the third six months of employment, 35s. per week of 48 hours.

Thereafter a Learner shall cease to be a Learner and be entitled to the General Minimum Time-Rate applicable to her under Sub-section (B) (1) of Section I of Part I of the above-mentioned Notice Z (8).

(iii) A Learner shall cease to be a Learner and be entitled to the full General Minimum Time-Rate applicable to her under Section I of this part of this Schedule upon the fulfilment of the following conditions :—

Age of entering upon Employment.	Conditions.

SECTION III.—For the purpose of this Notice the following definitions shall apply :—

A Learner is a worker who not being an apprentice as defined in Section II of Part III of the above-mentioned Notice Z (8) :—

(1) (a) Is employed during the whole or a substantial part of his or her time in learning (a) Cutting, or (b) Nailing, or (c) Cutting and Nailing in the Furriers' Section of the trade by an employer who provides the Learner with reasonable facilities for such learning; or,

(b) Being a female person, is employed during the whole or a substantial part of her time in learning (a) Machining, or (b) Lining, or (c) Finishing, or more than one of these operations in the Furriers' Section of the trade by an employer who provides

the Learner with reasonable facilities for such learning; and

(2) Has received a certificate or has been registered in accordance with rules from time to time laid down by the Trade Board, or has made an application for such certificate or registration which has been duly acknowledged and is still under consideration. Provided that the certification or registration of a Learner may be cancelled if the other conditions of learnership are not complied with.
