Bicycle, weight unladen not exceeding 200 lbs.	ten shillings.
Bicycle, weight unladen not exceeding 200 lbs. with right to draw trailer or sidecar	fifteen shillings.
Bicycle, weight unladen exceeding 200 lbs. but not exceeding 8 cwt.	one pound.
Bicycle, weight unladen exceeding 200 lbs. but not exceeding 8 cwt. with right to draw trailer or sidecar	one pound five shillings.
Tricycle, not exceeding 8 cwt. in weight unladen	one pound five shillings.

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 13TH DECEMBER 1921.)

LIVERPOOL (BIRKENHEAD) LANDING OF ANIMALS ORDER OF 1921 (No. 7).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Revocation.

1. The Liverpool (Birkenhead) Landing of Animals Order of 1921 (No. 6) is hereby revoked.

Definition of Irish Animals Landing Place.

2. All that space at the Port of Liverpool situate partly in the county borough of Birkenhead and partly in the county borough of Wallasey which is coloured pink on the plan (No. 35,440) sealed by the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, for the purpose of this Order, and deposited at the Ministry, is hereby defined as a Landing Place for Irish Animals.

Definition of Foreign Animals Wharf.

3. All that space at the Port of Liverpool situate partly in the county borough of Birkenhead and partly in the county borough of Wallasey which is coloured blue on the plan referred to in Article 2 of this Order, is hereby defined as a Foreign Animals Wharf for the purposes of the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and any Order of the Minister thereunder.

Commencement.

4. This Order shall come into operation on the fifteenth day of December, nineteen hundred and twenty-one.

Short Title.

5. This Order may be cited as the LIVERPOOL (BIRKENHEAD) LANDING OF ANIMALS ORDER OF 1921 (No. 7).
