(ii) The advances to be given to Learners shall become due as from the first Monday in January and July of each year, the Learner being entitled to her first advance from the first Mondav in January or July as the case may be, provided that she has been in the trade at l ast three months.

(iii) A Learner shall cease to be a Learner, and be entitled to the full General Minimum Time-Rate applicable to workers other than Learners, upon the fulfilment of the conditions appropriate to her as set out below :-
