MINIMUM RATES OF WAGES (AS VARIED) FOR MALE AND FEMALE WORKERS.

Effective as from 9th February, 1922.*

* Should this date not correspond with the beginning of the period for which wages are raid by an employer who pays wages at intervals not exceeding seven days, the rates shall become effective as from the beginning of the next full-pay period, but in any case not later than 15th February, 1922.

This Notice sets out all the Minimum Rates of Wages which have been fixed or varied by the Trade Board and takes the place of the Notices J. (2), J. (5), J. (8), J. (13a), and J. (17) issued by the Trade Board.

Provided that in cases where a Weaving Mistress has immedia'e responsibility for the instruction of not more than one Female Weaving Learner, the appropriate General Minimum Time-Rate set cut above shall only apply where the Weaving Mistress is paid by the employer in respect of such responsibility, the sum of not less than 5s. per week in addition to her own earnings on piece-work.

Note.--The method of remuneration prescribed in the foregoing proviso for a Weaving Mistress who has immediate responsibility for the instruction of rot more than one Female Weaving Learner shall rot apply in cases where a Weaving Mistress is engaged in instructing Learners of Weaving under a group system of instruction.
