apply so long as the restriction on movement prevents the removal of the stock, and for seven days after such restriction ceases to operate, and the owner of the stock shall be liable to pay to the person who affords any such facilities, or renders any such services, as aforesaid, in compliance with this Order, such sums by way of remuneration or recoupment of expenses as may be just and reasonable, the amount in default of agreement to be determined by arbitration under and in accordance with the provisions of the Second Schedule to the Agricultural Holdings Act, 1908.
