Notice of Application to Minister of Health.

NOTICE is hereby given, that the East Worcestershire Waterworks Company have made application to the Minister of Health under the above Act for an Order amending Section 42 of the East Worcestershire Water Act, 1877, and modifying the provisions of an Agreement dated the 7th day of September, 1891, between the East Worcestershire Waterworks Company of the one part and the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Droitwich, in the County of Worcester, being the Urban Sanitary Authority of the said Borough, of the other part, and determining the price to be charged by the Waterworks Company for or in connection with the supply of water by them in accordance with the following scale:—

For water, the sum of 1s. 3d. for every thousand gallons supplied, that is to say, by the substitution of 1s. 3d. for the figures 7d. and 6d. referred to in Section 42 of the East Worcestershire Water Act, 1877, and in the said Agreement of 7th September, 1891. But with provision for the quarterly variation of such scale in the event of and in sympathy with any variation in the cost to the Company of fuel or enginemen's wages.
