PART II.

GENERAL MINIMUM TIME-RATE FOR HOME-WORKERS.

SECTION I.

In the case of all Home-workers employed on piece-work to which no General Minimum Piece-Rates fixed by the Trade Board are applicable, each piece-rate paid must be such as would yield, in the circumstances of the case, not less than the appropriate General Minimum Time-Rate to an ORDINARY worker—i.e., a worker of ordinary skill and experience in the class of work in question.

SECTION II.

For the purpose of this Schedule the expression "Home-worker" means a worker who works in his or her home or in any other place not under the control or management of the employer.

PART III.

PIECE-WORK BASIS TIME-RATES FOR FEMALE WORKERS (OTHER THAN HOME-WORKERS AND OTHER THAN WORKERS EMPLOYED IN CARDING HOOKS AND EYES OR SNAP FASTENERS).

SECTION I.—ALL FEMALE WORKERS other than Home-workers and those employed in Carding	8½

In the case of all Female Workers to whom this Section is applicable, each piece-rate paid must be such as would yield, in the circumstances of the case, not less than 8¼d. per hour to an ORDINARY worker, i.e., a Female Worker of ordinary skill and experience in the class of work in question.

SECTION II.—All Female Workers of 18 years of age and over (other than Home-workers) employed in Carding (other than Carding Hooks and Eyes or Snap Fasteners)... .. .	8½

In the case of all Female Workers to whom this Section is applicable, each piece-rate paid must be such as would yield, in the circumstances of the case, not less than 8¼d. per hour to an ORDINARY worker, i.e., a Female Worker of ordinary skill and experience in the class of work in question.

PART IV.

OVERTIME RATES FOR MALE AND FEMALE WORKERS (ALL AGES).

SECTION I.

In accordance with Section 3 (i) (c) of the Trade Boards Act, 1918, the Trade Board HAVE DECLARED the Normal Number of Hours of Work in the Trade to be as follows:—

In any week	47
On Saturday	4½

Provided that all hours worked on Sundays and on Statutory Holidays shall be regarded as Overtime to which the Overtime Rates shall apply.

SECTION II.

The Minimum Rates for Overtime for all Male and Female Workers (other than Home-Workers and other than Female Workers employed in Carding Hooks and Eyes or Snap
