In the case of all Female Workers to whom Sections I and II of Part II of this Notice are applicable, each piece-rate paid must be such as would yield, in the circumstances of the case, not less than the appropriate piece-work basis time-rate to an ORDINARY worker of the classes specified, *i.e.*, a Female Worker of ordinary skill and experience in the class of work in question.

PART IV.

PROPOSED OVERTIME RATES AND VARIATION OF OVERTIME RATES FOR MALE AND FEMALE WORKERS.

In the case of Male and Female Workers of the classes for whom variations of minimum rates are proposed in Parts I, II and III of this Schedule, and in the case of Female Workers, other than Home-Workers, employed in Carding Hooks and Eyes or Snap Fasteners, for whom minimum rates are proposed in Parts II and III of this Schedule, Overtime Rates calculated on the minimum rates of wages proposed in Parts I, II and III of the Schedule in the manner specified in Part IV of the Schedule to the Trade Board's Notice O (11) shall apply in substitution for the proposed minimum rates set out in Parts I, II, and III of this Schedule in respect of all hours worked in excess of the number declared by the Trade Board in Part IV of the Schedule to the said Notice O (11) to be the normal number of hours of work in the trade.
