(GREAT BRITAIN).

MINIMUM RATES OF WAGES (AS VARIED) FOR MALE WORKERS IN THE READY-
MADE AND WHOLESALE BESPOKE SECTION OF THE TAILORING TRADE.

EFFECTIVE AS FROM 17TH APRIL, 1922.

NOTE.—Should this date not correspond with the beginning of the period for which wages are paid by an employer who pays wages at intervals not exceeding seven days, the rates shall become effective as from the beginning of the next full-pay period, but in any case not later than 23rd April, 1922.
