# MINIMUM RATES OF WAGES (AS VARIED) FOR FEMALE AND MALE WORKERS.

### Effective as from 28th June, 1923.

Should this date not correspond with the beginning of the period for which wages are paid by an employer who pays wages at intervals not exceeding seven days, the rates become effective as from the beginning of the next full pay period, but in any case not later than 4th JULY, 1922.
