(C)—The maximum period of Learnership on any one of the processes specified in (A) and (B) of this Section shall be :—

(a) As respects Learners employed in any one of the processes specified in paragraph (A) of this Section ONE YEAR

(b) As respects Learners employed in Flag-Making as specified in paragraph (B) of this Section TWO YEARS

The General Minimum Time-Rates applicable, on the expiration of the Learnership period or periods as above provided, to workers who have been employed as Learners shall be those for workers other than Learners as set out in Section I above.

If the conditions set out in Part IV of this Schedule are not complied with, the minimum rate applicable is that for workers other than Learners as set out in Section I above.
