SWINE-FEVER INFECTED AREA.

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

*Declaration of Swine-Fever Infected Area.*

1. The area described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be a Swine-Fever Infected Area for the purposes of the Swine-Fever (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1908.

*Commencement.*

2. This Order shall come into operation on the thirty-first day of July, nineteen hundred and twenty-two.

LIVERPOOL (BIRKENHEAD) LAND-  
ING OF ANIMALS ORDER OF 1922  
(No. 3).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested

in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

*Revocation.*

1. The Liverpool (Birkenhead) Landing of Animals Order of 1922 (No. 2) is hereby revoked.

*Definition of Irish Animals Landing Place.*

2. All that space at the Port of Liverpool situate partly in the county borough of Birkenhead and partly in the county borough of Wallasey, which is coloured pink on the plan (No. 36,167) sealed by the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, for the purpose of this Order, and deposited at the Ministry, is hereby defined as a Landing Place for Irish Animals.

*Definition of Foreign Animals Wharf.*

3. All that space at the Port of Liverpool situate partly in the county borough of Birkenhead and partly in the county borough of Wallasey, which is coloured blue on the plan referred to in Article 2 of this Order, is hereby defined as a Foreign Animals Wharf for the purposes of the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and any Order of the Minister thereunder.

*Short Title.*

4. This Order may be cited as the LIVERPOOL (BIRKENHEAD) LANDING OF ANIMALS ORDER OF 1922 (No. 3).

LAND DRAINAGE ACTS, 1861 AND 1918.

*River Colne Drainage District (Essex).*

Notice is hereby given, that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has prepared a draft Order under the Land Drainage Act, 1918, constituting a drainage district for certain lands drained by the River Colne and its tributaries from the point near Great Yeldham to the North Bridge in the Borough of Colchester, together with other lands drained by the Roman River and Salary Brook in the County of Essex.

A copy of the draft Order and of a 6-inch scale map showing the proposed drainage district has been deposited at the Office of the Town Clerk, Colchester, for public inspection
