Provided that all Female Workers of the classes specified in Section 1 (B) above, entering the trade for the first time at or over 16 years of age may be employed for a period not exceeding two months at a General Minimum Time-Rate which is less by ½d. per hour than the General Minimum Time-Rate applicable under the above Scale.
