The General Minimum Time-Rate for Learners under 14 years of age shall be varied from 1½d. to 1¼d. per hour. Such Learners shall from the age of 14 be entitled to the appropriate General Minimum Time-Rates shown in Column I above, all employment prior to that age being disregarded.

(i) The advances to be given to Learners commencing at under 21 years of age shall become due as from the first Monday in January and July of each year, the Learner being entitled to her first advance on the first Monday in January or July, as the case may be, provided that she has been in the trade at least three months.
