towards the cost of erecting a permanent Church within and for the said proposed separate District:

"And whereas the said capital sum of £2,000 has been contributed and paid as afore-said upon the understanding and condition that (such arrangement appearing to us to be expedient) the whole right of Patronage of the said proposed District, and, when such District shall have become a New Parish, then of the said New Parish, and the nomination of the Minister or Incumbent thereof should be assigned in the manner which is hereinafter set forth:

"And whereas the contributors of the said capital sum of £2,000 towards the cost of erecting such permanent Church have nominated to us the Bishop for the time being of the said Diocese of Chelmsford as the person to whom they desire that the whole right of Patronage of the said proposed District or New Parish should be assigned:

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend John Edwin, now Bishop of Chelmsford (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this Scheme), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, humbly recommend and propose that all those portions of the said New Parish of All Saints, Goodmayes, and of the said Parish of Dagenham which are described in the Schedule hereunder written, all which portions together with the boundaries thereof are delineated and set forth on the Map or Plan hereunto annexed, shall, upon and from the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme as aforesaid become and be constituted a separate District for spiritual purposes, and that the same shall be named 'The District of Saint Thomas, Becontree '.

"And we further recommend and propose that the whole right of Patronage of the said District so recommended to be constituted and, when such District shall have become a New Parish as aforesaid, then of the said New Parish, and the nomination of the Minister or Incumbent thereof shall without any assurance in the law other than this Scheme and any duly gazetted Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying the same and upon and from the day of the date of the publication of such Order in the London Gazette as aforesaid be assigned to and be absolutely vested in the said John Edwin, Bishop of the said Diocese of Chelmsford, and his successore, for ever.

"And we further recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid, or any of them, in accordance with the provisions of the said Acts, or of any of them, or of any other Act of Parliament."

"THE SCHEDULE to which the foregoing Scheme has reference.

"The District of Saint Thomas, Becontree, comprising:-

"I. All that portion of the New Parish (sometime Consolidated Chapelry) of All Saints, Goodmayes, in the County of Essex and in the Diocese of Chelmsford, which is bounded upon the south partly by the Parish of Barking and partly by the Parish of Dagenham, upon

the east by the said Parish of Dagenham, upon the north partly by the New Parish of Saint Chad, Chadwell Heath, and partly by the New Parish of Saint Paul, Goodmayes, all in the said County and Diocese, and upon the remaining side, that is to say, upon the west, by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Paul, Goodmayes, from the said New Parish of All Saints, Goodmayes, at the centre of the bridge which carries the main line of the Great Eastern Railway across Mayes Brook, and extending thence first southward and then in various directions along the middle of Mayes Brook (thereby passing through the Goodmayes Recreation Ground) for a distance of 1 mile and 3 chains or thereabouts to the centre of the bridge or culvert which carries Goodmayes Lane across the said brook, and extending thence southward along the middle of Goodmayes Lane for a distance of 141 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Longbridge Road upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of All Saints, Goodmayes, from the said Parish of Barking.

"II. And also all that contiguous portion of the said Parish of Dagenham which is bounded upon the north by the said New Parish of Saint Chad, Chadwell Heath, upon the west and upon the south by the above described portion of the said New Parish of All Saints, Goodmayes, and, upon the remaining side, that is to say, upon the east, by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of All Saints, Goodmayes, from the said Parish of Dagenham at a point in the middle of Green Lane distant 5 chains measured along the middle of such lane from its junction with Baron Road, and extending from the said point northward in a straight line (thereby following the proposed course of the new arterial road which will lead to Chadwell Heath Station) for a distance of 35 chains or thereabouts to the centre of the bridge which carries Chitty's Lane across the main line of the Great Eastern Railway upon the boundary which divides the said Parish of Dagenham from the said New Parish of Saint Chad, Chadwell Heath."

And whereas drafts of the said Scheme have, in accordance with the provisions of the secondly hereinbefore mentioned Act, been transmitted to the Patrons and to the Incumbents of the Cures out of which it is intended that the District recommended in such Scheme to be constituted shall be taken, and such Patrons and Incumbents have respectively signified their assent to such Scheme:

And whereas the said Scheme has been approved by His Majesty in Council:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice of His said Council, is pleased hereby to ratify the said Scheme, and to order and direct that the same and every part thereof shall be effectual in law immediately from and after the time when this Order shall have been duly published in the London Gazette pursuant to the said Acts.

And His Majesty, by and with the like advice, is pleased hereby to direct that this Order be forthwith registered by the Registrar of the said Diocese of Chelmsford.
