Declaration of Prohibited Area and Modification of Restrictions in Scheduled District.

- 2.—(1) The Area described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a Prohibited Area for the purposes of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Control of Movement) Order of 1920, hereinafter referred to as the "principal Order."
- (2) Part III. of that Order is hereby applied to the Scheduled District described in the Manchester District (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1922, as amended by this Order.
- (3) The provisions of Article 2 of the Manchester District (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1922 shall continue to apply to the Prohibited Area, and the provisions of Article 6 of the "principal Order" shall be read and have effect subject to this modifica-

Commencement.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the fourth day of September, nineteen hundred and twenty-two.

Short Title.

4. This Order may be cited as the Man-CHESTER DISTRICT (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1922 (No. 2).
