PROPOSAL TO VARY MINIMUM RATES FOR FEMALE AND MALE WORKERS.

In accordance with Regulations made under Section 18 of the Trade Boards Act, 1909, by the Minister of Labour, and dated respectively 31st October, 1918, and 1st August, 1922, the Trade Board established under that Act and the Trade Boards Provisional Orders Confirmation Act, 1913, for the Hollow-ware Trade, as defined in the Regulations made by the Board of Trade and dated the 6th July, 1914, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE, as required by Section 3 (5) of the Trade Boards Act, 1918, that they PROPOSE TO VARY the General Minimum Time-Rates and Overtime Rates for Female and Male Workers and the Piece-Work Basis Time-Rate for Female Workers of 18 years of age or over set out in their Notice dated 16th June, 1922, and effective under an Order of the Minister of Labour dated 9th June, 1922, the proposed variations being as set out in the Schedule below.
