## CANCELLATION OF GUARANTEED TIME-RATES FOR FEMALE PIECE-WORKERS.

The Guaranteed Time-Rates for Female Piece-Workers and the General Minimum Time-Rate of  $\frac{1}{2}$ d. per hour less, during the first six months' period of employment, than the General Minimum Time-Rate otherwise applicable in the case of Female Workers entering the Trade for the first time between the ages of 16 and 18 years, as set out in the Schedule to the Trade Boards Notice H.L. (8), dated 7th March, 1922, which became effective as from 8th March, 1922, are cancelled as from 11th September, 1922.

Signed by Order of the Trade Board and in pursuance of an Order of the Minister of Labour confirming the variation and cancellation of Minimum Rates of Wages made by the Trade Board and set out above, and specifying the 11th day of September, 1922, as the date from which such variation and cancellation should become effective.
