RETAIL BESPOKE TAILORING TRADE BOARD (GREAT BRITAIN).

PROPOSAL TO VARY MINIMUM RATES OF WAGES FOR MALE WORKERS (OTHER THAN CERTAIN CLASSES OF APPRENTICES AND LEARNERS).

In accordance with Regulations made under Section 18 of the Trade Boards Act, 1909, by the Minister of Labour, and dated respectively 31st October, 1918, and 1st August, 1922, the Trade Board established under the Trade Boards Acts, 1909 and 1918, for those branches of the Trade specified in the Trade Boards (Tailoring) Order, 1919, which are covered by the Regulations made by the Minister of Labour and dated 12th December, 1919, with respect to the Retail Bespoke Section of the Tailoring Trade in Great Britain, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE, as required by Section 3 (5) of the Trade Boards Act, 1918, that they PROPOSE TO VARY the General Minimum Time-Rates, Piece-Work Basis Time-Rates and Overtime Rates for Male Workers (other than certain classes of Apprentices and Learners) specified in Parts I and III of the Schedule to the Trade Board's Notice R.B. (20) dated 20th July, 1922, and effective under an Order of the Minister of Labour dated 15th February, 1922, the proposed variations being as shown in the Schedule set out below.
