

PART II.

PROPOSED VARIATION OF OVERTIME RATES FOR MALE WORKERS (OTHER THAN CERTAIN CLASSES OF APPRENTICES AND LEARNERS.)

Overtime Rates, calculated on the proposed Minimum Rates of Wages specified in Part I of this Schedule in the manner set out in Part III of the Schedule to the Trade Board's Notice R.B. (20) dated 20th July, 1922, shall apply in substitution for such proposed Minimum Rates of Wages in respect of all hours worked in excess of the number of hours declared by the Trade Board in Section I of Part III of their said Notice R.B. (20), to be the normal number of hours of work in the trade.

PART III.

SECTION I.

The proposed Minimum Rates of Wages set out in this Schedule shall apply, subject to the provisions of the Trade Boards Acts, to the respective CLASSES OF MALE WORKERS specified in this Notice, in respect of all time during which they are employed in Great Britain in any branch of the Retail Bespoke Section of the Tailoring Trade, as defined in the Regulations made by the Minister of Labour and dated 12th December, 1919, and set out in Section II of Part V of the Trade Board's Notice R.B. (20) dated 20th July, 1922.

Notwithstanding anything herein contained the proposed Minimum Rates of Wages set out in this Schedule shall NOT APPLY to PACKERS, *except* where they are employed on packing operations which are performed in a workroom.

NOTE.—The employment of Women, Young Persons, and Children is subject to the provisions of the Factory and Workshop Acts, and to the provisions of the Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children Act, 1920.

PART IV.

The above proposed Minimum Rates of Wages are without prejudice to workers earning higher rates of wages, or to agreements made, or that may be made, between employers and workers for the payment of wages in excess of these Proposed Minimum Rates of Wages.

The Trade Board will consider any OBJECTIONS to the above PROPOSAL TO VARY which may be lodged with them within two months from the 17th October, 1922. Such Objections should be in writing and signed by the person making the same (adding his or her full name and address), and should be sent to The Secretary of The Retail Bespoke Tailoring Trade Board (Great Britain), 1, Whitehall Gardens, Whitehall, London, S.W. 1.

It is desirable that the Objections should state precisely, and, so far as possible, with reasons, what is objected to.
