ORDER OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL IN ENGLAND.

(Dated 23rd October, 1922.)

Whereas under Section 21 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1874, the Registrar-General, with the sanction of the Minister of Health, may from time to time alter Registration Sub-districts:—

Now, therefore, I, Sylvanus Percival Vivian, Registrar-General of Births, Deaths and Marriages in England, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Births and Deaths Registration Acts, 1836 to 1901, and with the sanction of the Minister of Health, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Bishop's Stortford Registration of Births, &c. (Alteration of Sub-districts) Order, 1922, and shall come into operation on the first day of November, 1922.

2. The Interpretation Act, 1889, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The Civil Parish of Birchanger shall be transferred from Stansted Sub-district of Bishop's Stortford Registration District to Stortford Sub-district of the same Registration District.

4. The Stansted Sub-district, as altered by this Order, shall be extended by the addition of Braughing Sub-district of Bishop's Stortford Registration District and the extended Sub-district shall be called the Stansted Sub-district.

GAS REGULATION ACT, 1920.
