

1922, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

“ We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in pursuance of the Act of the 16th and 17th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 50, and of the Act of the 23rd and 24th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 124, have prepared, and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council, the following Scheme for effecting an exchange of the Patronage of the Benefice (being a Rectory) of Bradstone, situate in the County of Devon and in the Diocese of Exeter, for a part or share of the Patronage of the Benefice (being a Rectory) of South Pool, situate in the said County of Devon and in the said Diocese of Exeter:

“ Whereas the Advowson or perpetual right of Patronage of and presentation to the said Benefice of Bradstone is vested in Your Majesty, Your Heirs, and Successors, and is exercised on behalf of Your Majesty by the Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain for the time being:

“ And whereas two third parts or shares of and in the Advowson or perpetual right of Patronage of and presentation to the said Benefice of South Pool, that is to say, every turn or right of nomination or presentation to the said Benefice of South Pool which shall occur or arise on a vacancy of such Benefice happening after the date hereof for ever (with the exception of the next such turn or right of nomination or presentation and of every third succeeding turn or right of nomination or presentation thereafter) are vested in Henry Maitland Sperling, of Coombe Trenchard, Lewdown, in the said County of Devon, Esquire, J.P. (hereinafter referred to as ‘ the Trustee ’), as the Trustee of a Family Settlement for the purposes of the Settled Land Acts, 1882 to 1890, upon trusts under which the Reverend Maitland Kelly, of Kelly House, Lifton, in the said County of Devon, Clerk in Holy Orders, is tenant for life in possession thereof, free from incumbrances with divers remainders over:

“ And whereas the Right Honourable Frederick, Viscount Birkenhead, now Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain, and the said Maitland Kelly and the Trustee have respectively signified to us their desire that the patronage of the said two Benefices of Bradstone and South Pool may be rearranged by way of exchange in the manner which is hereinafter recommended and proposed:

“ And whereas we have made due inquiry and calculation as to the circumstances and relative value of the said two Benefices and of the Patronage thereof respectively, and we do hereby certify to Your Majesty in Council that the circumstances and present values of the said two Benefices are as set forth in the Schedule hereunto annexed:

“ And whereas the yearly value of the said Benefice of Bradstone in Your Majesty’s

Books is £6 7s. 2d. and the yearly value of the said Benefice of South Pool in the same books is £22 16s. 5½d.:

“ Now, therefore, with the consent of the said Frederick, Viscount Birkenhead, Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this Scheme), and with the consent of the said Maitland Kelly (as such tenant for life as aforesaid) and the Trustee (in testimony whereof they have set their respective hands and seals to this Scheme), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, humbly recommend and propose that upon and from the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme and without any conveyance of assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order, the whole Advowson or perpetual right of Patronage of and presentation to the said Benefice of Bradstone, and the Church thereof, shall be assigned and transferred from Your Majesty, Your Heirs, and Successors, and shall be and remain thereby vested in the Trustee upon and subject to the uses following, that is to say, to the use of the said Maitland Kelly for and during his life, and after his decease to the uses limited by and contained in the said Family Settlement, and may from time to time and at all times in perpetuity be exercised by the said Maitland Kelly and the persons for the time being entitled under the limitations of the said Family Settlement and their heirs and assigns, and that in exchange for the same the two third parts or shares of and in the Advowson or perpetual right of Patronage of and presentation to the said Benefice of South Pool, and the Church thereof, that is to say, every turn or right of nomination or presentation to the said Benefice of South Pool, and the Church thereof, which shall occur or arise on a vacancy of the said Benefice of South Pool happening after the date hereof for ever (with the exception of the next such turn or right of nomination or presentation and of every third succeeding turn or right of nomination or presentation thereafter) shall in like manner, and upon and from the same date, be assigned and transferred from the said Maitland Kelly and the Trustee and shall become and be absolutely vested in Your Majesty, Your Heirs, and Successors, and shall and may, from time to time, and at all times, be exercised on behalf of Your Majesty by the said Frederick, Viscount Birkenhead, or other the Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain for the time being.

“ And we further recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid, or any of them, in accordance with the provisions of the said Acts, or of either of them, or of any other Act of Parliament.
