

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the Vicarage of Shute, in the County of Devon and in the Diocese of Exeter, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same Vicarage, all and singular the yearly rectorial tithe, commutation, rent charges, which are particularly described in the Schedule hereunto annexed, and now vested in us: To have and to hold the said yearly rectorial tithe, commutation, rent charges to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever, such annexation to take effect as from the first day of October in the year one thousand nine hundred and twenty-two: Provided always that the said yearly rectorial tithe commutation rent charges expressed to be hereby granted and conveyed

shall be and be taken to be in lieu of and in full substitution for the yearly sum of one hundred and eight pounds heretofore payable by us the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners to the Incumbent for the time being of the said Vicarage of Shute, under the authority of an Instrument sealed by us on the twentieth day of November, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine, and published in the London Gazette on the twenty-eighth day of the same month and year, to which substitution the Reverend Stanhope Mackie Nourse, Clerk in Holy Orders, the present Incumbent of the said Vicarage, is consenting, and in token of such consent has signed this Instrument.
