WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant out of our Common Fund to the Incumbent of the Vicarage of Wormegay with Tottenhill, in the County of Norfolk and in the Diocese of Ely, and to his successors Incumbents of the same Vicarage one yearly sum or stipend of one hundred pounds, such yearly sum or stipend to be calculated as from the ninth day of October, in the year one thousand nine hundred and twenty-two, and to be payable in equal quarterly portions on the first day of February, the first day of May, the first day of August and the first day of November in each and every year: Provided always that the yearly sum or stipend hereby granted or any quarterly portion thereof shall be payable only upon the production to us on or after each of the said last mentioned quarterly days of payment of a certificate (in such form as may be required by us) under the hand of the Bishop of Ely, certifying that during the quarter then ended services to the satisfaction of such Bishop have been held in the churches at Wormegay and at Tottenhill within the Parish: Provided also that the yearly sum or stipend hereby granted shall be and be taken to be in lieu of and in full substitution for the early sum of one hundred and twenty pounds heretofore payable by us, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, subject to certain conditions as to the employment of an Assistant Curate under the authority of an Instrument sealed by us on the fourth day of November, in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty six, and published in the London Gazette on the twelfth day of the same month and year.
