NOTIFICATION OF INFECTIOUS DISEASES.

BARKING TOWN URBAN DISTRICT.

Notice is hereby given, under Section 3 (3) of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that by the Barking Town (Measles, &c., Regulations) Rescission Order, 1922, dated 3rd November, 1922, the Minister of Health has rescinded the Barking Town (Measles, German Measles and Whooping Cough) Regulations, 1920, which provided for the notification of cases of those diseases in the Urban District. The rescinding Order is published as Statutory Rules and Orders, 1922, No. 1200.

SHEFFIELD.

Whereas the Lord Mayor, Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Sheffield (hereinafter called the Corporation), being the Urban Sanitary Authority for the said Borough, have made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order, under Sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act, 1875, to partially repeal, alter or amend the Sheffield Corporation (Consolidation) Act, 1918, so as:—

(1) To enable the Corporation to capitalise interest and to suspend sinking fund on the cost of the purchase of lands for and the construction of the Broomhead and More Hall Reservoirs and works connected therewith, and the tramroad and works authorised by or referred to in Sections 47 and 48 respectively of the said Local Act of 1918, until the end of the year in which the Corporation commence to supply water from the said reservoirs and works;

(2) With reference to Sections 68 to 70 of the said Local Act, to provide for a permanent increased rate for the supply of water; and for this purpose—

(a) To prescribe in the said Provisional Order new rates and charges in lieu of those at present in force; the rates and charges proposed by the Corporation being those set out in an application now before the Minister of Health for an Order under the Water Undertakings (Modification of Charges) Act, 1921, notice of which application has been published in the local press and may be referred to at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Sheffield, at any time during ordinary office hours; and

(b) To enable the Minister of Health to revise the said rates and charges from time to time either by way of increase or decrease.

(3) With reference to Section 249 of the said Local Act to empower the Corporation to transfer a portion of Firth Park to the Corporation's Housing Estate in exchange therefor of other lands belonging to the Corporation adjoining Firth Park;

(4) With reference to Section 418 of the Local Act to authorise the Corporation to raise a sum not exceeding £1,000,000 on security of Bills, and

(5) For the several purposes of the Application or for purposes connected with, incidental to, or consequent on, those purposes to make any such alteration or amendment

of the said Local Act or of any other Local Act or of any Act confirming a Provisional Order made in pursuance of any of the Sanitary Acts or of the Public Health Act, 1875, and in force in the said city as may be necessary or desirable.

And whereas it is proposed that a Provisional Order should be issued in compliance with the said Application;

Notice is hereby given, that Edward Hugh Rhodes, Esq., Barrister-at-Law, one of the Inspectors of the Ministry of Health, will attend at the Town Hall, Sheffield, on Monday, the 20th day of November, 1922, at 10 o'clock in the forenoon, to hold a Local Inquiry into the subject-matter of the said Application and the proposed Provisional Order.

And notice is hereby further given, that any person interested may attend at such Inquiry and be heard with reference to the said Application and the proposed Provisional Order.

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 10TH NOVEMBER 1922.)

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Application of Part I. of Sheep (Double Dipping) Order of 1920.

1.—(1) Part I. (*Restriction on Movement of Sheep out of a Movement Area*) of the Sheep (Double Dipping) Order of 1920, hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Order," is hereby applied to the Area described in the Schedule hereto, which shall be a Movement Area for the purposes of that Order.

(2) This article shall come into operation on the twentieth day of November, nineteen hundred and twenty-two.

Application of Part II. of Sheep (Double Dipping) Order of 1920.

2. Part II. (*Double Dipping of Sheep in a Double Dipping Area*) of the Principal Order is also hereby applied to the Area described in the Schedule hereto, which shall also be a Double Dipping Area for the purposes of that Order.

Period Prescribed as Double Dipping Period.

3. The dates between which all sheep in the Area described in the Schedule hereto are to be dipped within the Area by the owner or person in charge of the sheep under and in accordance with Part II. of the Principal Order
