Act of the 7th and 8th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 94, of the Act of the 13th and 14th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94, and of the Act of the 32nd and 33rd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94, have prepared, and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council, the following Scheme or Representation for altering the boundaries of the New Parish of Saint Stephen, Brighton, in the County of Sussex and in the Diocese of Chichester:

"Whereas by the authority of an Order of His late Majesty King Edward the Seventh in Council bearing date the 12th day of August, 1907, and published in the London Gazette on the 23rd day of the same month a District Chapelry was assigned to the consecrated Church of Saint Stephen, Brighton, situate in the Parish of Brighton, in the said County of Sussex and in the said Diocese of Chichester, and the said District Chapelry was named 'The District Chapelry of Saint Stephen, Brighton ':

"And whereas the said District Chapelry of Saint Stephen, Brighton, has under the provisions of the Act of the 19th and 20th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 104, become a New Parish of the character contemplated by that Act, by the Act of the 6th and 7th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 37, and by the above mentioned Act of the 32nd and 33rd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94:

"And whereas it has been represented to us and it appears to us to be expedient that the boundaries of the said New Parish of Saint Stephen, Brighton, should be altered in the manner which is hereinafter mentioned:

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend Winfrid Oldfield, Bishop of Chichester (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this Scheme or Representation), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners humbly represent, recommend and propose that from and after the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme or Representation and without any assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order the boundaries of the said New Parish of Saint Stephen, Brighton, shall be altered so that all that portion of the said Parish of Brighton which is described in the Schedule hereunder written and is delineated and set forth upon the Map or Plan hereunto annexed and is thereon coloured pink, shall be dissevered from such Parish and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said New Parish of Saint Stephen, Brighton.

"And we further represent, recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from representing, recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid, or any of them in accordance with the provisions of the hereinbefore mentioned Acts, or of any of them, or of any other Act of Parliament.

"THE SCHEDULE to which the foregoing Scheme or Representation has reference

"The territory to be annexed to the New Parish of Saint Stephen, Brighton, in the County of Sussex and in the Diocese of Chichester, being:—

"An area contained in a portion of the District Chapelry to the Parish of Brighton, in the said County and Saint Wystan, Bretby Diocese, wherein the present Incumbent of Repton, in the Count such Parish still possesses the exclusive cure of Diocese of Southwell:

souls although it is isolated from the main portion of his Cure: which area is bounded upon all sides as follows, that is to say, upon the south by the sea, upon the west partly by the Parish of Hove and partly by the New Parish of Saint Patrick, Hove, both in the said County and Diocese, upon the north by the said New Parish of Saint Stephen, Brighton, and upon the east by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Stephen, Brighton, from the said isolated portion of the said Parish of Brighton at the junction of Western Road with Preston Street, and extending thence south-westward along the middle of Preston Street for a distance of 154 chains or thereabouts to its junction with King's Road and continuing thence south-westward in precisely the same direction and in a straight line to the sea."

And whereas drafts of the said Scheme or Representation have been transmitted to the Patrons and to the Incumbents of the Cures affected by the arrangements which are contemplated by such Scheme or Representation and such Patrons and Incumbents have respectively signified their assent thereto:

And whereas the said Scheme or Representation has been approved by His Majesty in Council:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice of His said Council, is pleased hereby to ratify the said Scheme or Representation, and to order and direct that the same and every part thereof shall be effectual in law immediately from and after the time when this Order shall have been duly published in the London Gazette pursuant to the said Acts.

And His Majesty, by and with the like advice, is pleased hereby to direct that this Order be forthwith registered by the Registrar of the said Diocese of Chichester.
