##### MEMORANDUM.

Hon. 2nd Lt. Arthur Stuart Darlow relinquishes his honorary commission on joining the Army.

The following Order has been made by the Secretary of State for Air, under Section 2 of the Air Ministry (Kenley Common Acquisition) Act, 1922:—

#### AIR MINISTRY (KENLEY COMMON ACQUISITION) ORDER, 1922.

Whereas by Section 2, Sub-section (1), of the Air Ministry (Kenley Common Acquisition) Act, 1922, it is provided that the President of the Air Council may by Order stop up, divert, or extinguish any public or private right of way over or on "the aerodrome site," as defined in the said Act, but that reasonable compensation shall be made in manner provided by Section 4 of the said Act to all persons who have any rights in any private right of way so stopped up or extinguished.

Now I, Sir Samuel John Gurney Hoare, Baronet, C.M.G., the President of the Air Council, in pursuance of the power conferred on me by the said Act, do hereby order as follows:—

(1) All public and private rights of way over or on so much of the aerodrome site which is verged red on the plan\* annexed to this Order shall be stopped up and extinguished as from the 20th day of November, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-two.

(2) All persons claiming compensation in respect of any rights in any private right of way so stopped up or extinguished shall lodge their claim in writing with the Secretary, the Air Ministry, Kingsway, W.C. 2, on or before the 31st day of December, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-two.

(3) This Order may be cited as the Air Ministry (Kenley Common Acquisition) Order, 1922.
