

Watchmen, Outside Messengers, Cleaners of Premises, Timekeepers, or to any other workers whose work stands in a relationship to the trade similar to that of the foregoing excluded classes.

NOTE.—The employment of Female Workers, Young Persons and Children is subject to the provisions of the Factory and Workshop Acts and to the Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children Act, 1920.

The Trade Board will consider any OBJECTIONS to the above PROPOSALS TO VARY which may be lodged with them within two months from the 26th December, 1922. Such Objections should be in writing and signed by the person making the same (adding his or her full name and address), and should be sent to The Secretary of the Sugar Confectionery and Food Preserving Trade Board (Great Britain), 1, Whitehall Gardens, London, S.W. 1.

It is desirable that the Objections should state precisely, and, so far as possible, with reasons, what is objected to.
