MINIMUM RATES OF WAGES (AS VARIED) FOR MALE AND FEMALE WORKERS (Except Certain Classes of Transport and similar Workers).

EFFECTIVE AS FROM 1ST JANUARY, 1923.*

* NOTE.—Should this date not correspond with the beginning of the period for which wages are paid by an employer who pays wages at intervals not exceeding seven days, the rates shall become effective as from the beginning of the next full pay period, but in no case later than 7th January, 1923.
