Provided that, in determining the age of entry and the length of employment all service prior to the age of 14 shall be disregarded.
- (c) A Learner's Certificate must be applied for to the Trade Board in respect of every Worker whom it is desired to employ at the special lower rates fixed for Learners. Unless a Learner's Certificate has been obtained, or application has been made to the Trade Board therefor, which has been acknowledged and is still under consideration, and unless the other conditions of Learnership laid down in Section I of Part IV of this Schedule are complied with, the minimum rate payable is that for Workers other than Learners.
