GENERAL MINIMUM TIME-RATES AND OVERTIME RATES OF WAGES
(AS VARIED) FOR MALE AND FEMALE WORKERS.

EFFECTIVE AS FROM 23RD FEBRUARY, 1923,*

except as regards the General Minimum Time-Rate for the Male Loom Tenters specified in Section I of Part I of the Schedule below, and the Overtime Rates based thereon, which became effective as from 8th January, 1923.

* Should this date not correspond with the beginning of the period for which wages are paid by an employer who pays wages at intervals not exceeding seven days, the rates shall become effective as from the beginning of the next full-pay period, but in any case not later than 1st March, 1923.

Provided that in lieu of the General Minimum Time-Rates set out above the General Minimum Time-Rates to apply for one period only of learnership not exceeding two months to Female Weaving Learners as defined in Part V of this Schedule who :—

- (a) in cases where a Weaving Mistress has immediate responsibility for the instruction of not more than one female weaving learner, are employed under conditions where the Weaving Mistress is paid by the employer in respect of such responsibility the sum of not less than 5s. per week in addition to her own earnings on piece-work ;
- (b) in cases where a Weaving Mistress has immediate responsibility for the instruction of more than one female weaving learner or is engaged in instructing learners of weaving under a group system of instruction, are employed under conditions where the Weaving Mistress is paid by the employer in respect of such responsibility or such instruction a sum to be arranged between the Weaving Mistress and her employer
