(c) To borrow, with the sanction of the Minister of Health, such sums as may from time to time be necessary for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Council in connection with the conversion of the existing closet accommodation;

(2) For the several purposes of the Application, or for purposes connected with, incidental to, or consequent on those purposes, to make any such alteration or amendment of the said Local Act or of any other Local Act or Act confirming a Provisional Order made in pursuance of any of the Sanitary Acts, or of the Public Health Act, 1875, in force in the said District as may be necessary or desirable;
