#### SMETHWICK CORPORATION (GAS).

**N**OTICE is hereby given, that application is intended to be made to Parliament in the present Session by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the borough of Smethwick (hereinafter called "the Corporation") for leave to bring in a Bill (hereinafter called "the Bill"), the principal subject-matters of which are as follows:—

To empower the Corporation to acquire by compulsion or agreement the land next hereinafter described, or some part or parts thereof (that is to say):—

A piece or parcel of land situate in the borough of Smethwick, in the county of Stafford, belonging or reputed to belong to Tangyes Limited, containing 3 roods 37 perches and 19 square yards or thereabouts, bounded on the north by other land belong-

ing or reputed to belong to Tangyes Limited, on the south by Foundry Lane, on the east by the piece or parcel of land belonging to the Corporation hereinafter described, and on the west by Rabone Lane.

To empower the Corporation upon the said piece or parcel of land (when acquired by them) and upon the piece or parcel of land next hereinafter described to construct, erect and maintain, alter, improve, enlarge, extend and renew or discontinue gasholders, receivers, drains, sewers, mains, pipes, meters, machinery and other works, apparatus and conveniences for the storage of gas, and to do all such acts as they may think proper for the storage of gas and of coke and other residual products obtained in the manufacture of gas and matters producible therefrom; to store gas upon the said lands, and to supply the same therefrom.

The piece or parcel of land lastly hereinbefore referred to is as follows:—

A piece or parcel of land belonging to the Corporation containing 1 acre 1 perch and 12 square yards or thereabouts, situate in the said borough of Smethwick, and bounded on the north by other land of the Corporation, on the south by Foundry Lane, on the east by land belonging or reputed to belong to E. G. Wrigley and Company Limited, and on the west in part by the piece or parcel of land hereinbefore described, and in part by other land belonging or reputed to belong to Tangyes Limited.

Plans showing the land, houses and other property proposed to be taken or used compulsorily under the powers of the Bill, with a book of reference to such plans will be deposited for public inspection on or before the 19th day of February instant with the Clerk of the Peace for the county of Stafford at his office at Stafford, and on or before the same day a copy of the said plans and book of reference will be deposited with the Town Clerk of the borough of Smethwick at his office at the Council House, Smethwick.

Printed copies of the Bill will be deposited in the Private Bill Office of the House of Commons on or before the 26th day of February instant, and on and after that day printed copies of the Bill may be inspected and copies obtained at the price of two shillings each at the respective offices of the undersigned Town Clerk and Parliamentary Agents.

A notice stating the objects of the intended application has been or will be published in full in the Smethwick Telephone of the 10th and 17th days of February instant.
