

The Minimum Rates of Wages set out in the Schedule below are effective as follows:

1. The General Minimum Time-Rates and Piece-Work Basis Time-Rates specified in Part I. of this Schedule and the Overtime Rates based thereon as from 1st March, 1923.*
2. The General Minimum Time-Rates and Piece-work Basis Time Rates specified in Part II of this Schedule, and the Overtime Rates based thereon as from 24th July, 1922.
3. The General Minimum Time-Rates specified in Section I of Part IV of this Schedule and the Overtime Rates based thereon as from 10th October, 1921.
4. In all other cases as from 29th May, 1922.

* Should this date not correspond with the beginning of the period for which wages are paid by an employer who pays wages at intervals not exceeding seven days, the rates become effective as from the beginning of the next full-pay period, but in any case not later than 7th March, 1923.
