#### PART V.

#### OVERTIME RATES.

Overtime Rates calculated on the appropriate minimum rate of wages specified in Parts I to IV of this Schedule in the manner set out in Part V of the Trade Board's Notice R.B. (23) daved 28th February, 1923, apply (subject in the case of apprentices to the provisions of Section III (2) (c) of Part IV of the Trade Board's Notice R.B. (23)) in substitution for the rates set out in Parts I to IV of this Schedule in respect of all hours worked in excess of the number of hours declared by the Trade Board in the above-mentioned Notice R.B. (23) to be the normal number of hours of work in the Trade.

(a) PACKERS, where employed on Packing operations which are NOT performed in a workroom.
