ACTS, 1911 to 1922.

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF  
AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 27TH MARCH 1923.)

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under Section 8 of the Importation of Animals Act, 1922 (Session 2), hereby orders as follows:—

1. The provisions contained in the Schedule to the said Act are hereby altered and modified in the manner hereinafter appearing.

2. Regulation 1 (2) (b) of the said Schedule shall be altered and modified so as to be in the following terms:—

“(b) premises (including a slaughter-house) other than a market.”

3. Regulation 2 (1) of the said Schedule shall be altered and modified so as to be in the following terms:—

“(1) Imported cattle which have been moved to an authorised market shall at all times while therein be kept separate from all animals other than imported cattle, sheep or goats, and shall not, if part only of a market is authorised for the purposes of this Schedule, be permitted while any animals other than imported cattle, sheep or goats are in the market, to enter any part of the market other than the authorised part.”

4. Regulation 2 (2) of the said Schedule shall be altered and modified so as to be in the following terms:—

“(2) No animals other than imported cattle, sheep or goats shall be permitted to enter an authorised market while it is being used as such.”

5. Regulation 4 (1) (b) of the said Schedule shall be altered and modified so as to be in the following terms:—

“(b) the lairs or enclosures must not be used for any animals other than imported cattle, sheep or goats in course of being moved to an authorised market under this Schedule.”
