

within the area of the council in any case in which it appears to him, as the result of the inquiry, to be proved that a vehicle of that class cannot be used on that highway without endangering the safety of the vehicle or the persons therein or of other traffic using the highway, or that the highway is unsuitable for use by a vehicle of that class;

And whereas the London County Council have made application to the Minister of Transport for an Order to be made in pursuance of the said sub-section prohibiting or restricting, subject to such exceptions or conditions as to occasional user or otherwise as may be specified in the Order, the driving of Heavy Motor Cars and Locomotives on the highways specified in the Schedule hereto:

Provided that nothing in the Order shall prevent the driving upon the said roads of any vehicle which is being used for the conveyance of goods or merchandise to or from any house, building or other premises situate on, or adjacent to, the said roads:
