

Schedule hereto, which shall be a Movement Area for the purposes of that Order.

(2) This Article shall come into operation on the first day of June, nineteen hundred and twenty-three.

*Application of Part II of Sheep (Double Dipping) Order of 1920.*

2.—Part II (*Double Dipping of Sheep in a Double Dipping Area*) of the principal Order is also hereby applied to the Area described in the Schedule hereto, which shall be also a Double Dipping Area for the purposes of that Order.

*Period Prescribed as Double Dipping Period.*

3. The dates between which all sheep in the Area described in the Schedule hereto are to be dipped within the Area by the owner or person in charge of the sheep under and in accordance with Part II of the principal Order are hereby fixed to be the thirty-first day of July and the tenth day of September, nineteen hundred and twenty-three.

*Restriction on Movement of Sheep into the Area.*

4.—(1) Sheep shall not be moved from premises outside the Area described in the Schedule to this Order to a place of destination in that Area (other than a market, fairground or saleyard), unless they are accompanied by a certificate granted by an Inspector of the Local Authority of the District from which the sheep are moved, to the effect:—

(a) that the sheep have, within fifty-six days before the movement, been dipped twice, with an interval of not less than ten and not more than fourteen days between the dippings, by a thorough immersion in a sheep-dip approved by the Minister for sheep-scab or purporting to be so approved, in the presence of an Inspector of the Local Authority of the District, and

(b) that the sheep have since the second dipping been kept isolated from sheep which have not been so dipped; and

(c) that the sheep have not been exposed in any market, fairground or saleyard at which there were at the same time exposed sheep which had not been so dipped.

(2) Sheep moved to a market, fairground or saleyard in the Area from premises outside the Area and moved thence to a place of destination in the Area shall as soon as practicable after their arrival at such place of destination be dipped twice, with an interval of not less than ten and not more than fourteen days between the dippings by a thorough immersion in a sheep-dip approved by the Minister for sheep-scab or purporting to be so approved, unless the sheep are accompanied by a certificate granted in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Article.

(3) This Article shall come into operation on the first day of June, nineteen hundred and twenty-three.

An Area comprising:—

The administrative county of the West Riding of Yorkshire (except the petty sessional division of Saddleworth and such portions of the petty sessional divisions of West Morley, Upper Agbrigg, Staincross, and Upper Strathforth and Tickhill as lie to the west of the railway from East Retford via Sheffield, Penistone, Huddersfield, Brighouse, and Sowerby Bridge, to Todmorden).

And also comprising the county boroughs of Barnsley, Bradford, Dewsbury, Halifax, Leeds, Rotherham and Wakefield, and such portions of the county boroughs of Huddersfield and Sheffield as lie to the east of the above mentioned railway.

LONDON (WEST HAM) AND DISTRICT  
(FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE)  
ORDER OF 1923.

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1922, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

*Area Affected.*

1.—(1) This Order applies to the Area described in the Schedule hereto. In this Order the Area is referred to as the Prohibited Area.

(2) If any farm (except any detached part) is partly within and partly outside the Prohibited Area the whole shall be deemed to be within the Prohibited Area.

*Prohibition of Movement of Animals into, out of, or within Prohibited Area.*

2. (a) The movement of cattle, sheep, goats or swine into or out of the Prohibited Area is prohibited, except as provided in the next following Article; provided that this Order shall not prevent the movement of animals through such Area direct by railway without avoidable delay if the animals are not untrucked within such Area.

(b) The movement of any such animal along or across any road or other highway or by water within the Prohibited Area is prohibited.
