

## ROPE, TWINE AND NET TRADE BOARD (GREAT BRITAIN).

## GENERAL MINIMUM TIME-RATES, PIECE-WORK BASIS TIME-RATES AND OVERTIME RATES (AS VARIED) FOR FEMALE WORKERS IN THE NET SECTION OF THE TRADE.

Effective as from 4th June, 1923.

Should this date not correspond with the beginning of the period for which wages are paid by an employer who pays wages at intervals not exceeding seven days, the rates become effective as from the beginning of the next full pay period, but in any case not later than 10th June, 1923.
